- 1. The VOD site will open on July 24 and the Zoom Webinar links will be released after July 31 in the VOD site.
- 2. The speakers, chairpersons and some invited persons join the Webinar as panelists who can use camera and microphone, but you can join as an attendee who can't use camera and microphone.
- 3. The attendee can see who are participating as panelists, but other attendees are hidden.
- 4. If you have a question or comment to the PL/SPL speaker, please write that using Q&A function of the Webinar, but don't use Chat function.
- 5. When the chairpersons allow you to talk, you can unmute the microphone and ask a question by yourself, but you can't use your camera function.
- 6. If the chairpersons change your role from an attendee to a panelist, then please turn on your camera and ask a question. Your name in Webinar becomes visible to all the participants.
